

# Forging Long Lasting Partnerships with Key Stakeholders



## REINTEGRATION COMPONENT

Aims to ensure that 3,000 returnee migrants, primarily from the European Union are sustainably reintegrated

### ACTIVITIES INCLUDE

- ◉ Providing immediate assistance to returnees based on immediate needs such as cash grants, emergency medical support, access to drop-in centers for assistance with food and temporary accommodation
  - ◉ Enabling migrants the access to planned and monitored reintegration services from the information and reintegration service centres
  - ◉ Providing returnee migrants with psychosocial services including medical treatment and trauma counselling through referral services
- Supporting returnee migrants, their communities, and families through community and stakeholder orientations and sensitization at the national, district, upazila and union level
- ◉ Facilitating economic reintegration through providing in-kind financial grants, assistance for small business setup, job placement and linking the returnees to different skills and livelihoods development programmes supported by the European Union (EU), Government of Bangladesh (GoB), private and NGO partners
  - ◉ Building capacity of the DEMO offices to provide reintegration and migration services to prospective and returnee migrants
  - ◉ Assisting further development of existing returnee migrant database with GoB to better support immigration and returns

## MIGRATION GOVERNANCE COMPONENT

Aims to support the Government of Bangladesh, and other migration actors to effectively manage migration at all levels

### ACTIVITIES INCLUDE

- ◉ Developing a comprehensive framework for facilitating orderly, safe, regular and responsible migration
- ◉ Enhancing the capacity of key stakeholders to implement the 'Overseas Employment and Migrants Act 2013 and Prevention and Suppression of Human Trafficking Act 2012
- ◉ Strengthening tools specific to migration indicators linked to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG)s and the 7th 5 year plan of Action
- ◉ Supporting multi-stakeholder co-ordination mechanisms to improve policies and practices
- ◉ Improving capacity to expand markets based on labour market analysis and consultations
- ◉ Improving mechanisms to monitor recruitment practices and promote ethical recruitment

## AWARENESS RAISING COMPONENT

Aims to ensure returning migrants, aspirant migrants, families, communities, local government and private sector consistently make informed decisions about migration, and practice and promote safe, orderly and regular migration behaviours, including remittance management

### ACTIVITIES INCLUDE

- ◉ Disseminating innovative, evidence based and contextualized information and sensitization messages
- ◉ Improving knowledge, attitude and practices of migrants, families and communities to better manage remittances
- ◉ Launching integrated and comprehensive Behaviour Change Communication campaigns to help potential and returnee migrants adopt the best practices for regular, safe and orderly migration and better manage remittances
- ◉ Developing capacity of local government authorities and non-government partners to promote regular, safe and orderly migration and sustainable reintegration
- ◉ Empowering migrants, families and communities to access appropriate financial services



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
